**CITIZEN COMMENTS ON GENERAL ISSUES/AGENDA ITEMS**

The City Clerk announced that members of the public wishing to address the Council on any subject shall be permitted to do so during this portion of the meeting by indicating a "raised hand" and activating their cameras at this time.

To allow maximum public involvement, each speaker will have one 5-minute period to interact with the Council, and must provide his/her name and street address prior to beginning his/her remarks. Screen-sharing or visual aids are not permitted.

The Council will consider all comments and questions, and will respond, if and when appropriate, which may or may not be during this meeting.

**Alysha Rodriguez of 487 Mountainview Avenue** expressed concerns about tax breaks, legislation of pilots, and Resolution 273-2025. In addition, she mentioned her right to voice concerns as a resident. Deputy City Attorney spoke to bond Ordinances and invited her to call the Law Department for more details.

**Dr. Gloria Boseman of 345 Olcott Street** expressed her concerns about not getting her concerns responded to. She spoke about the pilots and if it in fact it will enhance the quality of life in the city. CFO Nile Clements addressed the Emergency Appropriations. Deputy Business Administrator addressed the questions regarding pilots and their ability to “enhance the quality of life in the city”.

**Ann Hall of 241 Duane Street** inquired about the lay-offs in the city, are Councilmembers relatives being laid-off, and the Police Department lay-offs. What was the selection process for city lay-offs? Business Administrator Chris Hartwyk stated there are anticipated lay-offs but are still under discussions and will be determined by civil service standards. It will become public when it is determined if necessary and when civil service approves it. CFO Nile Clements stated Police is not funded by grant.

**Alice Lane of 400 Oakwood Avenue** expressed concerns of Domestic Violence and rodents in her senior building. She invited Council to come and celebrate her birthday next week. Council President Adrienne K. Wooten will connect Ms. Lane with the Police Chief. Deputy Business Administrator will send Code Enforcement | Task Force to investigate.

**Gerald Murphy of 26 North Harrison Street** apologized if he has offended anyone, expressed his concerns about the lay-offs, workforce housing, ticket revenue from speeding on Harrison Street. He personally addressed Councilwoman Wooten, stating that he addressed the issues on Berwyn Street.

### **COUNCIL COMMENTS**

Business Administrator Chris Hartwyk mentioned that the city has been discussing negotiations with the developer in regards to Councilmember Montague III’s request for an update on the Recreation Center.

**Council Vice President Tency A. Eason** expressed concerns about the budget season and stated they are working hard to make this budget work for the residents.

**Councilmember Quantavia L. Hilbert** expressed her concerns about some of the votes being made; if the project is not benefiting the City of Orange as a whole, especially its residents then the councilmembers should be more mindful of projects they’re passing.

Council President Adrienne K. Wooten called for a five minute recess.

**Councilmember Jamie B. Summers-Johnson** shared her stance on taxes and the new budget. She gave a shout-out to the Orange High School Boys' Basketball coach Carley for running a three-day basketball clinic.

**Council President Adrienne K. Wooten** spoke about the powers each councilmember has and suggests that the public research what the council does for legislation.


