TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 200, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", SECTION 200-33, ENTITLED SCHEDULE II: NO PARKING CERTAIN HOURS. (Central Avenue) (Sponsored by Councilmember Kerry J. Coley)

WHEREAS, finding adequate parking is a habitual issue encountered by the residents and patrons of business in the City of Orange Township; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange Township is consistently looking for new ways to address the parking needs within the City; and

WHEREAS, there is currently an Ordinance regarding parking restrictions on Central Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is need to adjust parking hours on Central Avenue to allow for street cleaning.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the City Council of the City of Orange Township that Chapter 200 of the Code is amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1.

a) **§ 200-10.33. Schedule II: No Parking Certain Hours.**

Chapter 200, Section 200-10.33 of the Code of the City of Orange Township be amended to include the following:

<u>Central Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.</u> <u>Monday</u>	<u>Between South Center Street and Ogden Street</u>
<u>Central Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>9:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.</u> <u>Wednesday</u>	<u>Between South Center Street and Ogden Street</u>

SECTION 2. Severability of Ordinance Provisions

Each section of this ordinance is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity of constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

SECTION 3. Conflict of Other Ordinance Provisions

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances and conflicts that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date of Ordinance Provisions

That this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage upon expiration of twenty (20) days following publication unless otherwise provided
