Alysa Rodriguez of 487 Mountainview Avenue, addressed the Council and expressed concerns regarding Tax Abatement, Resolution 60-2026, the election process, the 2026 Budget, homeowner advocacy, and low-income housing. **Business Administrator Chris Hartwyk and the Chief Financial Officer Nile Clements** responded and addressed several of the concerns raised.

Kelly Ann Joseph and David Joseph of 660 Nassau Street, spoke regarding parking issues, including parking signage. They also thanked the Council for addressing some of their concerns related to 433 Lincoln Avenue.

Dr. Gloria Boseman of 345 Olcott Street, stated that although she does not always receive answers to her questions during Council meetings, she intends to continue attending and raising her concerns. She spoke on issues including the time limitations for Citizens' Comments, housing development, the Developers Trust Fund, Board and Committee appointments, Local Advisory Committee, Resolution 62-2026, and the Temporary Budget.


