The Acting Municipal Clerk announced that the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:4-9 et. seq., "Sunshine Law" has been met. A notice of this meeting was posted on the Bulletin Board in City Hall, the Council's website ([www.orangetwpnjcc.org](http://www.orangetwpnjcc.org)), the City's website ([www.orangenj.gov](http://www.orangenj.gov)) and filed in the Office of the City Clerk.

### PUBLIC SESSION

The meeting presented the Tier A Municipal Stormwater General Permit and the city's Watershed Inventory Plan (WIP), with Remington Vernick Engineer Terry Vogt explaining the permit context and the contents of the WIP. Mr. Vogt described the WIP as a desktop analysis that integrates surface-water and watershed data, demographic and land-use information, and newly digitized stormwater-infrastructure datasets, and he noted the draft was prepared for filing before the New Jersey DEP January 1, 2026 submission deadline and is being finalized now. He also stated a one-page fact sheet and his contact information were provided and offered to answer follow-up questions by email.

The session fulfilled the first of two required public hearings; no members of the public spoke during the hearing and the council moved to close the hearing.

A motion to close hearing was made by Councilman Clifford R. Ross seconded by Councilwoman Quantavia L. Hilbert.

**Motion adopted**



**Motion Adopted**


The meeting was adjourned at 6:40pm.
